



# Business Security Checklist

Side 1

**Use this as a guide as check your business for safety measures. Boxes marked “no” indicate areas where you could take action to improve your businesses security. These are just some of the steps you can take to decrease the likelihood that you or your business is targeted.**

## Exterior Doors

**Yes**      **No**

- All doors are locked when the business is closed or unoccupied—even if it’s just for a few minutes.  Yes       No
- Doors are solid hardwood or metal-clad.  Yes       No
- Applicable doors feature wide-angle peepholes at heights everyone can use.  Yes       No
- If there are glass panels in or near our doors, they are reinforced in some way so that they cannot be shattered.  Yes       No
- Entryways have a working, keyed entry lock and a sturdy deadbolt lock installed into the frame of the door.  Yes       No
- Spare keys are kept with a trusted employee/manager, *not* under a doormat or planter, on a ledge or in the mailbox.  Yes       No

## Garage and Service Bay Security

- The door leading from any garages to the business are solid hardwood or metal-clad and protected with a quality keyed door lock and deadbolt.  Yes       No
- Any overhead garage doors have locks so that you do not rely solely on the automatic door opener to provide security.  Yes       No
- Garage and Service Bay doors are locked when leaving the business.  Yes       No
- Any sliding glass doors have an anti-slide lock or a snug-fitting dowel in the track.  Yes       No
- \* Key locks not recommended as they may prevent exit in the event of a fire.*
- A dowel or pin to secure a glass door has been installed to prevent the door from being shoved aside or lifted off the track.  Yes       No
- Any sliding doors are locked every night and each time leaving the business.  Yes       No

## Protecting Windows

- Every window in the business has an anti-slide lock or is securely pinned.  Yes       No
- \* Key locks not recommended as they may prevent exit in the event of a fire.*
- Windows are always locked, even when they are opened a few inches for ventilation.  Yes       No

## Outdoor Security
