

Frequently Asked Questions

When is registration?

Registration begins at **8:00am** on Tues, March 19th- Shoreline Residents; Thursday, March 21st- Lake Forest Park Residents; Friday, March 22nd- Everyone

What are the hours of Camp Shoreline Day Camp?

8:00 am – 4:00 pm, except for Camp Excel and Camp Explore which are 10:00 am – 3:00 pm.

I don't see "aftercare," is that still offered?

We are no longer offering "aftercare." It is now an "extended day," option from 7:30 am -5:30 pm. This option is available at registration for all Camp Shoreline camps except Outdoor Camp, Camp Excel, and Camp Explore. Specialty Camps, Outdoor Preschool Camps and Sports Camps do not offer an extended day option.

Is "extended day," an extra fee? If so, how much?

Yes. The fee is \$30/Res, \$36/Non-Res, \$32.12/Lake Forest Park- per week.

Will "extended day" fill up like "aftercare," used to?

No. We have as many spots as we have campers for this new option.

Where is the "extended day" option when I go to register online?

After you hit the register button, you will see prompts where you can add this option at the bottom of the page before you add the camp to your cart. It will be listed beneath the Connie King Scholarship Donation line. You must select the fee in order to register for extended day.

Can I add "extended day" after I have already registered?

Yes, this option may be added at a later date by calling 206-801-2600 or stopping by Spartan.

I have signed my camper up for a morning and afternoon specialty camp as well as the lunchtime care. Do I have the "extended day" option as well?

No. The "extended day" option does not apply to specialty camps which end at 4 pm.

Morning specialty camps are over at 12 pm and the afternoon specialty camps don't start until 1 pm. What do I do if I want to sign my child up for both the morning and afternoon camps?

We are now offering **supervised free** lunchtime care from 12:00 pm -1:00 pm for those signed up for BOTH a morning specialty camp and an afternoon specialty camp. Campers will be picked

up from their morning camp at 12:00 pm and brought in to join Camp Shoreline Day Camp for lunch and recess. They will then be walked back in time for their afternoon specialty camp. Lunchtime care only available at Spartan Recreation Center and Ridgecrest Elementary Camps.

***We can also offer this to those who sign up for certain sports camps as long as the camper is signed up for another camp that makes it a full day.**

How fast do camps fill up?

Camp Shoreline Day Camps are traditionally full within the first hour of registration opening. Other camps may still fill up within the first week of registration, it depends on the camp.

What do I do if Camp Shoreline Day Camp is full?

You always have the option of placing your child on the waiting list and strongly encourage you to do so.

We understand planning for summer camps can be challenging which is why we offer many other options. We offer free Lunchtime care when combining a morning and an afternoon camp. This gives additional options for a full day.

My camper is on a waitlist, now what?

Spartan Recreation Center will notify you if a spot has opened up in the camp your child is waitlisted for. ***Please make sure your contact information is correct.*** If you miss the call, please follow the directions left on the message. These messages are time sensitive, so if you wait too long to call back, your spot will be given up.

If I withdraw my camper from Camp Shoreline day camp after the first Monday in June and put them on a waitlist for another Camp Shoreline day camp, do I have still pay the administrative fee?

Yes. The fee will only be waived if you transfer from one camp into another Camp. Meaning there is an open spot and the registration is completed at the same time the withdrawal is made.

Do you offer any sort of financial aid to help pay for camp?

Shoreline does offer scholarships for Shoreline residents. You can find the application online at: www.shorelinewa.gov/parks or at Spartan Recreation Center - 202 185th St. NE. Shoreline, WA. 98155. Qualifications: eligibility for free or reduced lunch through the Shoreline School district for the current school year, enrolled in Head Start, or a letter from DSHS showing approval for services during the current year.
