Richmond Beach Saltwater Park Native Habitat Restoration

Volunteers work with University of Washington students and Friends of Saltwater Park to remove invasive plants, stabilize steep areas, and plant native species. We provide the snacks, water, work gloves, and tools. Bring your own lunch, wear sturdy shoes, and dress for the weather. Work is done on a slope and uneven ground so be sure to wear closed-toed shoes. Meet near the rest room in the lower parking lot to sign in and pick up your tools for the day.
