

RESOLUTION NO. 124

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON,
AUTHORIZING THE RIDGECREST NEIGHBORHOOD
ASSOCIATION TO PROCEED WITH EXPENDITURE OF ITS
OFFICE OF NEIGHBORHOODS MINI-GRANT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the 1996 budget of the City of Shoreline allocated \$5,000 for neighborhood enhancement in each of Shoreline's 12 neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funding provided by the City will be matched by the participating neighborhood in a donation of cash, goods, or labor equal to the value of the City grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgecrest Neighborhood Association has submitted a grant application for this program, which has been reviewed by City staff; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgecrest Neighborhood Association has joined together with the Paramount Park Neighborhood Group in a restoration project of Pacific Tree frogs to wetlands in Paramount Park; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 54 requires City Council approval of expenditure of Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funds,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1. Authorization. The City Council hereby approves the expenditure of \$2,000 of the Office of Neighborhood Mini-Grant funding for the Ridgecrest Neighborhood Association project of frog restoration in Paramount Park wetlands.

Section 2. Recording of Mini-Grant Application. The Ridgecrest Neighborhood Association Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant application has been filed with the City Clerk and given Clerk's Receiving Number 281.
