## RESOLUTION NO. 337

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON  
AMENDING THE NEIGHBORHOOD MINI GRANT PROGRAM  
TO TRANSFER INDIVIDUAL GRANT AND RULE AMENDMENT  
AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER; AND AMENDING  
RESOLUTION 54**

WHEREAS in Resolution No. 54 adopted on February 12, 1996 the City Council established a Neighborhood Matching Grant Program, also known as the Neighborhood Mini-Grant Program; and


WHEREAS the City Council desires to transfer individual grant approval and rule amendment authority from the City Council to the City Manager;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1. Section 3 of Resolution No. 54 is hereby amended as follows:

**Neighborhood Grants.** There is established a Neighborhood Matching Grant Program, the process and administration of said funds to be handled by the Office of Neighborhoods. The allocation of total available funds shall be determined from year to year by appropriation of the City Council. All such grants to individual Neighborhood groups shall be governed by rules approved by the City Manager Council. The City Manager Council shall approve individual grants prior to their implementation by the City.
