DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL: The City of Shoreline is proposing amendments to the Shoreline Development Code (SMC Title 20) that apply citywide. The 2017 batch of amendments are small, mixed updates to the Development Code. The proposed amendments include new and updated definitions, uses such as microbreweries and brewpubs, revised setbacks, administrative corrections, accessory dwelling units, tree retention, Critical Area updates, and general administrative corrections, procedural changes, policy changes, clarifying language, and codifying administrative orders.
