The building features a variety of sustainable features, including solar panels, energy-efficient lighting, and water-saving fixtures. The building also has a green roof and a rainwater harvesting system.


Impact



- Complete Streets grant for shared use path from 5th Ave. NE to 195th Street pedestrian bridge over I-5




How many plows did the City use during the snow event?
