RESOLUTION NO. 59

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON DECLARING ITS INTENT TO REMOVE FRED T. WILMETH AS CITY MANAGER PURSUANT TO RCW 35A.13.130 AND SUSPENDING WILMETH IMMEDIATELY UNTIL HIS PERMANENT REMOVAL BECOMES EFFECTIVE

WHEREAS, Fred T. Wilmeth entered into an employment agreement with the City of Shoreline which provides that Wilmeth is an "at will" employee who serves at the pleasure of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.13.130 provides that a City Manager may be removed by a majority vote of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Shoreline, Washington, has lost confidence in Fred T. Wilmeth's ability to effectively lead city staff; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that Fred T. Wilmeth has not been able to effectively communicate with the City Council, the Planning Commission and city staff; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Declaring an Intent to Remove Fred T. Wilmeth as City Manager. The City Council hereby declares its intent to remove Fred T. Wilmeth as the City Manager of the City of Shoreline, Washington pursuant to Section 6.1 of the employment agreement dated October 10, 1995 and RCW 35A.13.130.

Section 2. Suspending Fred T. Wilmeth until his removal becomes effective. Fred T. Wilmeth is hereby suspended effective immediately until his removal becomes effective.


