

ORDINANCE NO. 168

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 146, AS AMENDED, BY INCREASING THE APPROPRIATION FROM THE SPECIAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FOR FOUR PUBLIC WORKS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the 1998 Budget was adopted in Ordinance No. 146; and amended by subsequent ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently developing the City's first six-year capital improvement program (CIP) through a public information and involvement process; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to proceed on several immediate capital improvement projects while the public information and involvement process is being implemented and conducted; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for and received notification of award for several capital improvement grants to begin the design and work on these more immediate capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shoreline is required by RCW 35A.33.075 to include all revenues and expenditures for each fund in the adopted budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amending Section 3 of Ordinance No. 146. The City hereby amends Section 3. of Ordinance No. 146, the 1998 Annual Budget, by increasing the appropriation from the Special Capital Improvement Fund by \$323,445 to \$13,204,540 and by increasing the Total Funds appropriation to \$45,368,603 as follows:


Section 2. Funds to Design and Construct Capital Improvement Projects. The City Manager is hereby authorized to expend the sum of \$467,560 from the Special Capital Improvement Fund for the design and construction of four new capital improvement projects as follows:

15 th Avenue NE and NE 165 th Street Traffic Signal	\$ 196,560
North 155 th Street Rechannelization and Improvements	100,000
Curb Ramps Program	59,000
25 th Avenue NE Pedestrian Improvements	<u>112,000</u>
	\$ 467,560

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be preempted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or preemption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective Date. A summary of this ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
